

The Twitter Success Sheet

- The great thing about Twitter is you can post much more explicit content than you can on IG. However, header and profile pic cannot be explicit – nothing censored, implied, or too hot (your account can get deleted for this).
- Tweet at least once/day.
- Putting two images in the same tweet that are somewhat related (same outfit but different poses, same pose but different outfits, different poses and outfits that relate to each other in some way, etc.) is very popular and will increase engagement.
- Do a Retweet trade at least once/day.
- Do a fresh post trade when you can.
- Retweet your own tweets on occasion.
- Don't Retweet too much or your page will seem spammy.
- Respond to comments.
- Include a caption with your photos that promotes engagement (a question, a witty comment, a provocative message, etc).
- How you promote OF on Twitter is up to you. Here are your choices: 1) OF link in bio or not, 2) OF as website link or not, 3) mention OF in captions or not. I have OF in my bio and as my website, but I do not mention it in captions (I used to

on occasion, but I sensed my engagement went down when I did, so I stopped). Some models Retweet a second account on their main account and that second account mentions OF. In general, I think you should try to avoid over-mentioning your OF, as it can seem spammy. I've also noticed less engagement when I use XXX language, so I don't do that too much either (but that's my brand).

- The level of hotness of your photos/videos is also up to you. It can range from non-nude to implied nude to full nude to hardcore. I only do implied nude, so my Twitter is hotter than my IG but not as hot as my OF. Whatever you choose should integrate with your production chain across your various socials and make your Twitter serve a unique purpose. So, for example, my Twitter is basically a free version of my low-price OnlyFans – I post almost the same photos on both, but no videos on my Twitter. So it serves as a kind of “free tour” of my low-price OnlyFans.
- Some people say that the more explicit your content, the less you'll get “suggested” and you might even be shadow-banned, but “organic” or “suggested” growth on Twitter (compared, for instance, to IG) is minimal.
- You can use other platforms to get people to your Twitter with the goal of getting it to a certain level so you can start trading. I did this at first, but now I grow through Retweet groups and promo.
- Growth on Twitter primarily comes from promos or Retweet groups. There are different Retweet groups on Twitter and Telegram, and they vary according to size of account, explicitness of content, and frequency of posting (some require a lot of Retweeting, so you need to decide if that's right for you). I recommend these three (and I'm always growing my list, so if you know of any, DM me):
 - Here's the basics on finding Retweet opportunities:
 - Make sure you have messages on so you can see SFS requests.
 - Message girls thru IG to trade on their Twitter.
 - Message girls on Twitter to trade on Twitter (though I have found it takes a lot of messages to get a response).

- Tweet at girls suggesting collaboration (but have this will show up in your replies, not in your feed).

- Message girls on Telegram to trade on Twitter.

- Hashtags are more important and safer on Twitter than on IG. I don't use hashtags on IG because they can increase reports. Words are also searchable as hashtags on Twitter, so talking about trending topics helps your account and it's not risky like it is on IG.

- You can SFS in your Twitter story with other models, and I recommend it.

- You can certainly reuse IG content on Twitter but ideally you post something that is more explicit than on IG so people have an incentive to follow you on Twitter.

- I have heard of Twitter promoters and tried a couple early on, but they've all seemed scammy. If you know a good one, DM me.

- Assuming you have adult content you will want to go to Settings > Privacy & Safety > Your Tweets and make sure that your material is marked as Sensitive (this option may be greyed out).

- Before trading with a girl you should assess the realness of her profile (since you can buy fake followers on Twitter, just like you can on IG). The best way to assess a page's realness is to look at the Followers-to-Likes ratio. My account is all real, and I have a Followers-to-Likes ratio of 2% (I have around 70k followers and generally get around 1400 likes per Tweet). I would not suggest trading with a page that has less than a 1% Followers-to-Likes ratio. Also, likes are much more important than Retweets, since girls and promoters are using Retweet groups and this falsely inflates their engagement. Finally, look at a girl's media and check out the photos of her (don't get confused by looking at things she has Retweeted since those were never an indication of her engagement). The photos of her should have a 1% or above Followers-to-Likes ratio or she probably has bot followers.
